The main goal of the fest is to promote innovation, creativity, teamwork, and technical skills among students.

! General Rules (Applicable to All Events)

- Participants must be currently enrolled students and carry a valid school ID.
- Registration must be completed before the deadline.
- Reporting time must be strictly followed.
- Any form of **cheating, misconduct, or rule violation** will result in disqualification.
- Judges' decisions are **final and binding**.
- Organizers are not responsible for loss or damage of personal belongings.
- Use of offensive language or behavior is strictly prohibited.

1. Hackathon — Rules

- **Team Size:** 2–4 participants.
- All work must be done **during the hackathon time only**.
- Pre-built projects are **not allowed**.
- Use of open-source libraries and frameworks is permitted.
- Internet usage is allowed for learning and reference only.
- Final submission must include:
 - Source code
 - Working demo
 - Short presentation
- Use of AI is fully allowed but the participants must have knowledge and should be able interpret manually. (They may be asked).

2. Free Fire and PUBG Mobile Tournament — Rules

- Team must have 4 members and 1 substitute is optional.
- Players must follow **official in-game (Free Fire and PUBG) rules**.
- The participants must be from **class 8 to class 12**.
- Players must use their own game accounts with proper name.
- Emulators are **not allowed**. (Only Mobile.)
- Use of hacks, mods, scripts, or unfair means is strictly prohibited and may lead to disqualification.
- Players must join matches on time; late entry may result in disqualification.
- Final match decisions will be made by referees and organizing team.

3. Graphic Designing — Rules

- Theme will be provided on the spot.
- Designs must be **original and created during the competition**.
- Any design software is allowed.
- Internet use is allowed for assets, but plagiarism is not allowed.
- Final design must be submitted within the given time.
- Judges will evaluate creativity and relevance to theme.

4. Scratch Programming — Rules

- Participants must use **Scratch programming platform only**.
- Projects must be created during the competition time.
- Participants may create games, animations, or interactive stories.
- Internet access may be restricted.
- Copying existing Scratch projects is not allowed.
- Clear explanation of project logic is required.

5. Typing Battle — Rules

- Typing test will be conducted using a **standard typing platform**.
- Participants must type the given text accurately within the time limit.
- Errors, speed, and accuracy will determine ranking.
- Use of auto-typing tools or scripts is strictly prohibited.
- Judges' system results will be final.

6. CSS Battle — Rules

- Participants must use **HTML & CSS only**.
- Design reference will be provided at the start.
- Use of JavaScript or external frameworks is not allowed.
- Internet access may be restricted.
- The goal is to replicate the design as accurately as possible.
- Code quality and visual accuracy will be judged.

Description:

Participants will compete in a **programming challenge** where they must design and develop a project within the hackathon timeframe. Focus is on logic, problem solving, and practical implementation.

-  Best Concept — NRs. 2,000

2. Esports — Free Fire Tournament

Description:

Compete in an exciting **Free Fire battle tournament** teams battle it out to win by strategy, skills, and survival in the game.
